Household waste and bulky items (→ subject to charges)

Waste for incineration

Household

Packaging material, plastic items, cat litter, etc.

Bulky items

Sofas, matresses, carpets, wooden and plastic tables, skis, detergent containers, etc.

Organic waste (→ subject to charges)

Waste for composting

- Only in comb-lift containers (140 770 liters).
- Food and kitchen waste (no bones), leaves, grass, coffee grounds, hedge trimmings, balcony and pot plants (no soil).
- Branches and shrubs max. 1.5m long, 50cm diameter, in bundles of max. 20kg or in containers.
- Put out leaf waste between October and March in open, easy-to-empty containers (max. 20kg) (→ free of charge), e.g. in baskets, plastic bags with handles (no plastic bags without handles, no plastic buckets); Christmas trees can also be put out (→ free of charge).
- NO PLASTICE (→ NOT PERMITTED: plastic and other non-biodegradable items)

Paper & cardboard (→ free of charge)

Put out newspapers, books, envelopes, cardboard, folded boxes (no poylstyrene or plastic, no detergent boxes) tied up or in containers.

Glass (\rightarrow free of charge)

Empty glass bottles; jam, honey, and other glass jars for food.

$\textbf{Metal} \ (\rightarrow \mathsf{free} \ \mathsf{of} \ \mathsf{charge})$

Tins, pans, metal fencing, tin plate, aluminum, etc. Bicycles: please label "zur Entsorgung".



Disposal site (→ free of charge)

Stones, roof tiles, panes of glass, windows, mirrors, flower pots, concrete and fiber-cement items.

Plastic waste (→ subject to charges)

- Sheets (e.g., magazine wrappers, plastic wrap), plastic bottles (e.g., milk, oil), thermoformed trays (e.g., biscuit packaging), composite items such as packaging for cold meats and cheese, drinks cartons (e.g., Tetra Pak), buckets, flower pots, yogurt pots, carrier bags, etc.
- Heavily soiled packaging, e.g., packaging from marinaded barbeque meat, packaging with remains, single-use items (containers, plates, cutlery, etc.), toys, garden hoses must go in regular household garbage bags.
- There is a separate collection for PET drinks bottles.
- Collection points: E. Bigler Transporte AG, Gümligen and Migros Gümligen.

Animal carcasses

- Small animals of up to 10 kg can be disposed of on private property (not in the water protection zone).
- Animals of up to 200 kg from non-commercial slaughtering can be handed in at the animal carcass collection point (Tierkörpersammelstelle) at the Institute for Animal Pathology in Bern, Länggassstrasse 122, 3012 Bern.
- Large animals over 200 kg will be collected directly (GZM Extraktionswerk AG, 3250 Lyss, phone 032 387 47 87).

These belong at the waste collection point

The following waste and unwanted items can be disposed of at the council waste collection point:

(→ free of charge)

- PET
- Iron, metal, tin cans, and aluminum
- Paper and cardboard
- Glass, bottles, food jars
- Waste for landfill (small quantites)
- Old clothes
- Natural corks
- Cooking and motor oil (small quantities)
- Electric and electronic equipment from the office, household, or garden
- Lighting fixtures and lamps (neon tubes, low-energy bulbs, etc.)
- Small batteries and rechargeable batteries
- Nespresso capsules

(→ subject to charges)

- Waste for incineration (household waste/bulky items)
- Organic waste (small quantities)
- Tyres with or without rims
- Car batteries

Miscellaneous

- There are additional containers for usable clothes and shoes, and glass (separate colours) in Gümligen and Muri.

Waste disposal charges

Waste that is subject to charges must have a sticker for the appropriate volume.

Purchase

- Waste stickers are available from all grocery stores and the Shell gas station in Muri.
- Single labels for organic waste are available from Migros stores in Gümligen and Egghölzli, Coop stores in Muri and Gümligen, and the Berger bakery in Muri.
- Bags for plastic waste are available from Bäckerei Berger in Muri, Coop stores Muri, Gümligen, and Egghölzli, Denner Gümligen, and Migros Gümligen.
- All waste stickers/labels, bags for plastic waste and annual permits for organic waste are available from the council offices in Muri.
